Here are some activities for you to choose from this half term to do at home.

We expect you to complete a minimum of 3 by **Monday 22nd October**.

We then expect you to complete at least another 4 by **Monday 17th December**.

You can bring in any of the work you have completed on any Monday to share with the class.

Your activities will be given a stamp:

You can use your homework book to record any written work or drawings or photographs.

Our class topic is: Famous Faces - Children have decided they would like to learn about famous people who have made some sort of difference in the world and throughout history and discover how and why they became famous. We will be looking at famous athletes, sportspeople, authors, scientists, inventors and explorers, to name just a few.

Make up a rhyme or a song that helps you remember odd and even numbers.

Think about how you would explain to someone else the easy way to learn them.



Write numbers in the correct order starting from 1. Challenge yourself. Present it in any way that you prefer.



Draw or present a famous person. Write key words or facts about them. Make it interesting for the reader.



Design a poster of how to keep safe on Bonfire Night. Be as creative as you like.



Use rhyming words to make silly sentences about a topic of your choice.



Practise number bonds up to 10, 20 and 100.

Magic number - make a number of your choice in a variety of different ways.



Go for an autumn walk. Collect interesting items, take photos or draw what you see. Write key words.



Read something interesting and tell us all about it. This could be a story, an information leaflet, a recipe or a notice.



Play a board game with a friend or family member to take turns and follow the rules. Take a photo or draw the game.



Write about a time when you were kind or someone was kind to you. Tell us all about it.

Think of something really special or interesting you would like to do or share. It could be anything you like that you would like to share with us.
