& Communication

Oracy

Develop their ability to use a range of syntax structures in terms of vocabulary and terminology in their talk.

Organise what they say so that listeners can understand.

Listen carefully and make connections between what they are learning and what they already know.

Explain information and ideas using relevant vocabulary.

Use talk purposefully to complete a task in a group

Speak clearly varying expression to help listeners.

Contribute to class discussion, sharing ideas and information.

Reading

Read short information texts independently with concentration.

Begin to recognise and understand the basic features of texts.

Use a range of strategies to make meaning from words and sentences, including knowledge of phonics, word roots and word families.

Look for specific information in texts e.g. to inform, instruct, explain.

Use visual clues.

Identify how texts are organised, e.g. *lists, numbered points, diagrams with arrows, tables and bullet points.*

Use information from texts in their discussions.

Develop the ability to read texts with fluency, accuracy and enjoyment; respond to them orally.

Writing

Proofread and give an opinion about their own written work and that of others; identify ways to improve and begin to edit.

Review and improve sections of their work.

Use nouns, pronouns, adjectives, adverbs, prepositions, connectives and verb tenses in their writing.

Present processes, event or reports in a clear sequence.

Use an increasing imaginative vocabulary .

Use adjectives and adverbs to expand simple sentences and phrases

Use full stops, question marks, exclamation marks and commas for lists

Use strategies including knowledge of word families, roots, morphology and graphic knowledge to spell words

Spell high frequency words correctly.

<p>Mathematics & Numeracy</p>	<p>Transfer mathematical skills to a variety of contexts and everyday situations. Identify the appropriate steps and information needed to complete the task or reach a solution. Identify multiples of 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10; use the term multiple. Use halves and quarters. Halve 2-digit numbers in the context of number, money and measures. Represent data using: lists, tally charts, tables and diagrams Extract and interpret information from charts, timetables, diagrams and graphs. Find fractional quantities linked to known multiplication facts, e.g. 1 / 3 of 18, 1 / 5 of 15. Use mental strategies to add and subtract 2-digit numbers. Use partitioning to double and halve 2-digit numbers. Weight/mass: use 5g, 10g and 100g weights. Capacity: use litres and half litres; measure to the nearest 100ml. Use standard units to estimate and measure. Explore sequences of whole numbers involving addition and subtraction, e.g. counting in 2s, 3s and 4s from different starting points.</p>
