



Our School Promise

At Barker's Lane School we will do our best to:







 Adhere to any social distancing rules as set out by Welsh Government as much as we reasonably can;



 Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child's well-being, mental health and academic needs;



 Contact parents/carers if your child is unwell or displays symptoms of COVID-19;



 Continue our clear and consistent approach to behaviour as set out in the Behaviour Policy;



 Communicate between home and school through our free school app, SeeSaw, Google Classroom, newsletters, text messages, email and the school website.

Our Parent / Carer Promise

To help my child at school, I know and understand that:



If my child is unwell, I will not send them to school;



If my child, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19, I will not send them to school, we will all begin to self-isolate and the member with symptoms will request a test and follow TTP procedures. I will let the school know as soon as possible via the absence form on the school website:



• If my child, is unwell or shows symptoms of COVID-19 at school, I will collect my child from school immediately;



 When dropping my child off and picking them up, I will stick to the 2 metre social distancing rules;



 When dropping off and picking up, I will strictly stick to the school timings for my child. I understand that it may be more difficult for them to access the school building if we are late;



 My child must not bring any items into school with them each day or take items home from school unless they been specifically asked for by school e.g shower proof coat; water bottle, snack (Y1-6) and a lunchbox.



 I will remind my child about social distancing rules in an age appropriate way but accept they are difficult to follow and that my child and others may not always do this successfully;



- I will support my child to use good respiratory and hand hygiene;
- I will not attempt to access any part of the school building. If I have any
 queries / concerns, I need to contact my child's teacher through Seesaw,
 email the school office or as a last resort telephone. I understand that
 my child's teacher will get back to me as soon as they can;



- I will support all staff in their efforts to create an 'as safe as possible' environment;
- I will read all letters/messages/emails that are sent home;



 I need to inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carer and emergency contacts details;



 If my child's behaviour or actions are deemed unsafe, I will be contacted by school to discuss this for my child's own safety and the safety of others.

Our Pupil Promise

I will do my best to:



- Stay with my class group all day;
- If possible tell an adult if I feel unwell;
 Not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school unless I have permission to do so from school;



- Only enter and exit the school building from the designated gate and door which school adults show me;
- Keep a safe distance from adults in school where I can;



• Follow good respiratory hygiene: coughing and sneezing into elbow or tissue (catch it-bin it-kill it); put my tissue in our special 'tissue bin';



• Follow good hand hygiene – use soap and water for 20 seconds or hand sanitiser if I am unable to wash my hands;



Behave well at all times to keep myself and others safe.
